DANIEL LOWERY EARNS SEVENTH CAREER CIRCUIT RING

Arkansas' 'Duma' Lowery collects \$17,657 and title in Double-Stack Event #5

Daniel "Duma" Lowery, of Peter Pender, Arkansas, has collected his seventh career Circuit ring by winning Event #5 at Circuit Hard Rock Tulsa, \$400 No-Limit Hold'em Double Stack. The victory also brought Lowery a \$17,657 first-place payday.

Lowery battled through one of the toughest Circuit fields at Tulsa to date in collecting the win and his seventh ring, good for a 10th-place tie on the all-time Circuit list. Among his final-table opponents were three other prior ring winners, including 11-time winner Maurice Hawkins.

Lowery badly wanted to win at Hard Rock Tulsa, which the Arkansas sawmill owner considers his "home" poker room. "I got second here twice before, each of the last two years. So it was a little vindication to win."

Lowery wasn't even sure he'd play in this series, but recent bad Midwest weather changed his plans. "I wasn't going to play because of work, but it's been so wet, we decided I'd take a week and a half off and come up here and try to win a ring."
