## MICHAEL PERRONE WINS SECOND PLO RING IN A MONTH

Chicago-based psychologist-turned-poker-pro wins Event #9 at Circuit Hard Rock Tulsa

Michael Perrone's new career as a professional poker player is going well. Perrone, 29, now living in Chicago, earned his second career Circuit ring by winning Event #9 at Hard Rock Tulsa, \$400 Pot-Limit Omaha.

Not only is it Perrone's second career Circuit win in a PLO event, it's his second win in less than four weeks. He took down the PLO event at the recent Horseshoe Hammond [IN] stop, near Chicago, and this repeat win cements his status as a rising PLO star. It also comes less than eight months after this former school psychologist from Texas relocated to Chicago with his girlfriend as she took a job there.

Though Perrone focuses on PLO cash games, he's increasingly serious about his tournament play, whenever he can find a PLO event. "There aren't that many PLO events, so it's pretty cool when you get to win one," he said. Perrone also credits coaching he's received from 2015 WSOP Main Event winner Joe McKeehen in further improving his game.
