ANDRE ALLEN GRABS RING IN EVENT #12, NLHE 1-DAY

Former auto-plant worker caps exceptional series with \$17,070 payday

Kansas City, Missouri's Andre Allen topped off a fantastic trip to Circuit Hard Rock Tulsa by winning Event #12, \$400 No-Limit Hold'em (1 Day). Allen's triumph was worth \$17,070 and gives the veteran Circuit player his first career gold ring.

"It's been a long grind," he told the WSOP. "I'm just happy to finally get the win. I've been at this 18 years. I've been traveling [to play events] since 2012. This stop was a good one." Allen's victory added to one of this series' standout performances. He has cashed four times at Hard Rock Tulsa, including three deep final-table runs; the two others, both within the past week, resulted in second- and fourth-place finishes. "The third time's the charm!" he exclaimed. The win also gives him a good chance to emerge with this stop's Casino Champion honors.

Allen has no special plans for his big payday and series, other than to continue boosting his poker bankroll. Next stop: Council Bluffs, Iowa, for the next Midwest-based Circuit series.
