Breaks occur after every two levels and last 20 minutes. Dinner break on Day 1 will be after the completion of level 6 and last 90 minutes. There will be a 60 minute break on subsequent playing days after the completion of 4 levels. Play will continue on Day 1 until the completion of round one. Day 2 Round Two begins at 2:30 PM. Round Two players will start with 150,000 in Chips. Play will continue on Day 2 until the completion of round two. Day 3 Final table at 2:30 PM. Players will start the final table with $1,500,000$ in Tournament Chips. Play will continue on Day 3 until a winner has been determined. $4.2 \%$ of the total entry pool will be withheld for entry fees, and $1.8 \%$ of the total entry pool will be withheld for tournament staff.
