- Players may choose to start at 12:00 PM (Flight A) or 5:00 PM (Flight B).
- Players eliminated from Flight A may re-enter flight B. Players may not re-enter the same flight.
- \$1,675 buy-in (\$1,500 prize pool + \$175 administrative fee) (Administrative fee includes any and all staffing/dealer fees, and rake)
- Winner will also receive an entry into the WSOP National Championship.
- Day 1 will play until the completion of level 12. No Dinner Break on Day 1 of the re-entry. 10 minute break for every 2 hours of play.
- Day 2 will resume at 12:00 PM the following day merging players from both flights. There will be a 10 minute for every 2 hours of play.
- Day 3 will resume at 12:00 PM. There will be a 10 minute break every 2 levels.
- Players may register until the start of level 13 for the Championship Event.
