## Payout Information for Colossus - $\$ 1$ million guaranteed to 1st place June 2-7, 2018

1. For each starting flight, a standard WSOP payout list will be calculated after late-registration closes (approx. 4 hours after event start time). This list will be based on paying out approximately $15 \%$ of that flight's field.
2. For example, if Flight A has 1000 players, a payout table for 150 places paid will be generated.
3. Using the example of 150 places paid, participants who finish in $150^{\text {th }}$ place or higher in Flight A will receive the respective payout for that place in that flight.
4. The same process will occur for flights: $B, C, D, E, \& F$.
5. The total number of participants and remaining prize pool from each flight will be combined together for Day 2.
6. The remaining prize pool for participants surviving Day 1 will be calculated using the percentage ratios derived from the appropriate WSOP payout table that represents the TOTAL number of participants for the event.
7. For example, suppose there are 25,000 total entries from all six flights, and 2500 advance to Day 2. The appropriate ratios for places 1-2500 of a payout table based on 25,000 entries will be used.
8. The lowest payout on Day 2 will be greater than the highest payout from any Day 1 flight.
9. The winner is guaranteed a payout of exactly $\$ 1$ million.
10. Participants who are eliminated in the money during a Day 1 flight (and do not advance to Day 2) may re-enter a later flight. It is therefore possible to cash in more than one flight.
11. On the official list of results on WSOP.com, all players advancing to Day 2 will be listed in the order in which they are eliminated on Days 2, 3, and 4. Players who make the money but who do not advance to Day 2, will be listed in the order of total payout amount received. (Using the above example, places 1 through 2500 will be based on order of elimination on Days 2, 3, and 4. Places 2501 and later will be based on payout dollar amounts for Day 1 eliminations).
12. Player of the Year points will be calculated using places on the official list of results, described above.
