Day 3 - play will resume at $2: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ and continue down to a winner or the completion of 10 levels, whichever comes first. Day 4 - if needed, play will resume at $2: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ and continue until a winner has been determined.
