TOURNAMENT RULES

A full copy of the tournament rules is available at the player's request.

- Registration begins 2 hours prior to the start of the tournament.
- Tournaments may be limited based on table availability.
- 3. Tournament buy-in includes a \$10 entry fee and \$5 staff fee.
- 4. Tournament players receive \$5,000 in tournament chips.
- Entry fee 100% to the house. Staff fee 100% to the dealers and tournament supervisor.
- 6. Entries can be purchased up until the end of the first break if tournament spots are available. If one of these seats is still open and you bust out before the first break, you may purchase a second entry and will be moved to that seat. One entry per person only, with the exception of a re-entry for the 2 levels as above. Alternates will be allowed entry until the end of the second level at Management's discretion.
- 7. Once a tournament has started there will be no refunds.
- 8. The appropriate starting amount of chips will be placed on the table for each paid entrant whether the person is present or not. Absent players will be dealt in and all chips necessary for blinds will be placed into the pot.
- If you would like to void your entry prior to the start of a tournament you must notify the poker room cashier. Once you have voided an entry you cannot re-enter that same tournament.
- 10. House Rules will be used for these tournaments.
- 11. Poker Room etiquette required for tournament play. Profanity or loud abusive language will not be tolerated. Players will be disqualified and their buy-in and entry fee will be forfeited.
- 12. Maximum number of entrants will be determined at Management's discretion.
- Management reserves the right to alter tournament or discontinue at any time.
- 14. In the event of a dispute, the floor person's decision is final.
