Bryan Campanello Captures Pot-Limit Omaha Win WSOP bracelet winner earns 2nd career ring.

Bossier City, LA (November 15, 2013) – Since turning 21, Bryan Campanello is having quite the 2013. Prior to today, Campanello had seven Circuit cashes, including two final tables and a Circuit ring. As if that wasn't enough, Campanello cashed twice at the the 2013 WSOP, including a bracelet victory in the Razz event.

Hit 2013 hot streak continued today at the Horseshoe Bossier City. Campanello outlasted 104 players to win his second career Circuit ring in the \$365 Pot-Limit Omaha Event #9.

Only six players were left standing after Day 1 with Campanello holding a substantial chip lead. Despite starting the final table with just six players, the \$365 PLO Day 2 was the longest of the Bossier City Circuit at over seven hours.

Bryan Campanello and Jason Mayfield, who also is a Circuit ring winner, battled headsup for over two hours. The two traded the chip lead back and forth before Campanello finally was able to come out with the victory.

For his win, Campanello took home \$9,360 as well as his second Circuit ring.

"It's all about the 50 points," Campanello said after his win.

Campanello will look to add to his WSOP National Championship points tomorrow as he will be joining the Day 1B field of the Horseshoe Bossier City Main Event.

Notes on the Event

- The final table took seven hours to complete.
- Both Bryan Campanello and runner-up Jason Mayfield are Circuit ring winners.

With his victory, Campanello earns 50 points towards the Horseshoe Bossier City Casino Champion standings. The current leader in the race is Dale Roesel, who holds 72.5 points. The player who accumulates the most overall points in Horseshoe Bossier City's twelve combined gold ring tournaments earns the title Casino Champion and receives an automatic entry into the 2014 WSOP National Championship, as will the winner of the Horseshoe Bossier City Main Event. All players who cash in ring events will receive points that apply to both the Casino Champion race and the season-long race to claim one of the at-large National Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season.
