Aiman Abbassi Wins His First WSOP-C Ring

Mashantucket, CT (August 13, 2015) — The second Omaha tournament on the schedule was of the Pot Limit variety. 79 entrants showed up for Event #7, creating a \$23,755 prize pool. The small field meant only the final 8 players would make the money, so the bubble was unusually at the final table.

When the dust had settled, Aiman Abbassi collected his first World Series Of Poker Circuit ring along with the \$7,840 first place prize. Aiman got close before, finishing 2nd at an event at last year's WSOP Circuit right here at Foxwoods Resort & Casino. The Poughkeepsie, NY local plays poker part time when not running his other two businesses.

Aiman cashed in 132nd place in the opening event, giving him a total of 52.5 points, good for 4th place on the Venue Leaderboard. The player who accumulates the most overall points during Foxwoods Casinos's 12 combined gold ring tournaments earns the title Casino Champion and receives automatic entry into the WSOP National Championship. Additionally, all players who cash in ring events earn points that apply toward the season-long race to claim one of 60 expected at-large National Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season.
