**Stateline, Nev.** (**November 9, 2015**) -- Ting Ho has outlasted 122 players, including her boyfriend, and gold ring winner, Rex Clinkscales, to win the final event of the 2015 Harveys Lake Tahoe series. Both Ho and Clinkscales had busted the Main Event. They hopped in this final event for a little bit of fun. It became even more fun for them when they were moved to the same table.

"Both he and I busted the Main, so we were just screwing around. He decided this tournament he was going to bust me," said Ho. "We were at the same table and he tried everything he could to bust me, but then the table broke, so he didn't get that opportunity."

It was a good thing Clinkscales didn't bust Ho, because she went on to win the tournament, earn her first gold ring and the top prize of \$10,249. Clinkscales was the happiest person in the room when the final river card hit and Ting won. He said that he was even happier then when he wins a tournament, so ultimately he wanted to bust her early, but ended up loving the outcome much more.

Ho began Day 2 second in chips out of eight remaining players. She made it all the way down to heads-up play and her opponent was two-time gold ring winner, Mark Bonsack. Bonsack already had a runner-up finish this series and was hungry for a victory. Ho overcame a 2:1 chip lead to beat Bonsack heads up.

"I am so happy because I wanted to get a ring for my dad," said Ting. "I think he will be really happy."

Ting is headed home to see her nieces and nephews and then she is most likely off to Planet Hollywood for the next stop on the Circuit.

Event #12 was the 12th and final gold ring event on the WSOP Circuit schedule at Harveys Lake Tahoe. The \$365 No-Limit Hold'em tournament attracted 122 players generating a \$36,600 prize pool. The top 15 players were paid.

Day 1 began Sunday at 3 p.m. and lasted 18 levels. Day 2 began Monday at 1 p.m. with eight players remaining. The tournament concluded at about 4:10 p.m. at the beginning of Level 23.

Steve Foutty won the Casino Championship this year at Harveys Lake Tahoe. It is the second consecutive year Foutty has won the Casino Championship at this property. He earns a seat to the 2016 Global Casino Championship.

All players who cash in ring events receive points that apply toward the Casino Championship race and the season-long race to claim one of 50 at-large Global Casino Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season.
