David Lee Wins Final Event in Tunica

After several close call, David Lee get his first Circuit ring.

David Lee has just won the final event of the 2018 Horseshoe Tunica Circuit. He defeated a 254-player field in Event #12: \$365 Double Stack No-Limit Hold'em Turbo to earn his first WSOP Circuit gold ring and the top prize of \$18,667. Lee defeated Warren Sheaves heads up for the ring. This was Sheaves' second final table of the series. He also made the final table in the six max event.

"First ring I have ever won, so it feels awesome," said Lee.

Lee has had many close calls in the past. Prior to this event, Lee had reached four final tables, but never came away with the ring. Three of those final tables were Main Event final tables. He finished 3rd in the 2015 Lumiere Place (St. Louis) Main Event for \$61,839, 5th in the 2016 IP Biloxi Main Event for \$31,870 and 6th in the 2014 Harrah's Tunica Main Event for \$35,009.

The 50-year-old is from Memphis, Tennessee and besides playing the Circuit also plays a few events at the Las Vegas [World Series of Poker](#) each year. He has satellited into the \$10,000 Main Event the past three years, but hasn't found a cash yet. Lee plans to play a few more Circuit events this season and then head to Vegas for the Colossus.
