WILLIAM WATSON WINS 2ND WSOP CIRCUIT RING IN HAMMOND

William Watson wins his second ring exactly one month after winning his first one.

William Watson is the champion of Event #8 at Horseshoe Hammond, defeating a field of 220 players to win the \$600 Six-Max. The victory is Watson's second on the WSOP Circuit, he won his first exactly one month ago a Seminole Coconut Creek. "It feels good, it took a lot faster to get than my first one. I've been playing poker for nine years."

Watson enjoys the six-max format "I love it, there's more space at the table and it plays faster." Watson came to the final table as the shortest stack, he doubled through the chip leader two-time ring winner Blake Whittington and ran that momentum to victory. The heads up battle against Whittington was "Long, hard and tough. I ran really good heads up though, I can't complain".

The Lexington Kentucky native took home \$30,592 for his victory.
