PAUL SOKOLOFF WINS THIRD CAREER CIRCUIT RING

England's Sokoloff wins turbo-format Event #3 and \$10,791 at Circuit IP Biloxi.

WSOP veteran Paul Sokoloff made his first trip to a Circuit event in Biloxi, Mississippi a memorable event, triumphing in Event #3 at IP Biloxi to win his third career Circuit ring. The win was worth \$10,791, pushing the 49-year-old Londoner's career WSOP earnings to nearly \$800,000. The win also marked Sokoloff's 103^{rd} combined cash in WSOP and WSOP Circuit events.

Sokoloff arrived in Biloxi fresh off a solid performance at the Circuit Planet Hollywood stop in Las Vegas in late November. Sokoloff cashed three times there, including eighth- and second-place finishes, but it was that near miss that was on his mind while he celebrated his win. "I was a little mortified by that, because I felt like I had an advantage. But this made up for it."

The win also gives Sokoloff 50 valuable Casino Championship points and puts him well into the hunt for this stop's Casino Champion title. Sokoloff is already eyeing that season-ending event, and he plans on playing a full slate of events in Biloxi as part of that quest.
