RUSSELL SULLIVAN WINS RING IN NLHE 1-DAY BATTLE

South Carolina's Sullivan earns \$13,539 and second career Circuit ring after lengthy duel

West Columbia, South Carolina's Russell Sullivan, a frequent participant in Circuit events in the South, ended a dry run lasting nearly two years in winning his second career Circuit ring in Event #7 at IP Biloxi. Sullivan earned his first ring in January 2017 in an event at Horseshoe Tunica, but since then, he's cashed numerous times but managed only one-final table appearance.

That stretch ended Tuesday with his win in this one-day tourney that turned into an unexpected marathon. Sullivan brought a chip lead to the final table, but he had to survive multiple all-ins just to stay at the table, then win a heads-up, two-hour duel for the ring.

"It's amazing to finally final-table something again and win," he said. "It was just my night." He'd have to wait until morning, though, to tell his wife and two children the good news, as the event stretched into the wee-wee hours of Wednesday. Meanwhile, it was time for R & R: "It was a battle. I'm tired, and just ready to go to sleep."
