ANTONY VIDMER WINS HIS FIRST CIRCUIT RING AFTER DEFEATING 274 PLAYERS

Antony Vidmer, the scribe and director of *High Roller: The Stu Ungar Story*, created his own story today by winning Event #12: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em Big Blind Ante. He topped a field of 274 entries to collect his first WSOP Circuit Ring.

Vidmer started the final table as the chip leader and gave it his best to close it out.

"You have to play well, to be disciplined and to wait for your spots, but then you also have to be able to take risks when the time is right, and I did. I came back from kind of a cooler hand right towards the end when we were down to four-handed. When we got heads up, I ran well again. I represented exactly what I wanted to represent and managed to pull out the win."

Many ring winners made the final table including Eric Salazar who got 3rd and Charles Adkins who got 2nd. Vidmer, who's been around poker long enough, believes playing against such professionals can be easier than against amateurs who are unpredictable.

"They're good. I've been playing for a while. I've played enough and been around enough good players to recognize good play and the spots they're going to pick. I've learned enough over the years to finally close it out with these guys. I would prefer to play frankly with good players than with crazy players who aren't that good, cause you never know what you're going to get. You can kind of estimate a range more easily with pros, lay it down with more confidence or even go for it with more confidence."

Vidmer will be taking home \$21,702, along with his first WSOP Circuit ring.
