Peter Morris AKA The Saurus Wins the Six Max

Peter Morris reps his lucky Larry legend jersey to WSOP victory.

Battle rapper and poker player Peter Morris has outlasted a 247-player field in the \$400 no-limit hold'em six-handed event at the Rio Las Vegas Circuit to earn \$21,599 and his first career WSOP Circuit ring. The cash marked Morris' ninth career WSOP cash. Morris, originally from the Bay Area, now calls Las Vegas home.

Morris splits his time between playing poker and rapping in the competitive battle rap scene. Morris, who goes by "The Saurus" is a two-time Scirbble Jam champion, winning the event in 2006 and 2007, which at the time was the biggest battle event in the world. Morris still battles regurlay and was recently featured in a movie called "Bodied," which was produced by Eminem and directed by Joseph Kahn. Morris wasn't the only poker player in the film. Also making an appearance on screen was six-time bracelet winner Daniel Negreanu. Erick Lindgren and Justin "Boosted J" Smith were also involved in the making of the film.

Morris can now add World Series of Poker Circuit champion to his long list of accomplishments.

"I feel amazing," said Morris. "It's my first ring, so I'm really excited, and it's my third win in the lucky Larry legend jersey."

Morris plays poker regularly when not competing in a battle rap event. He prefers tournaments over cash and plays a lot of online poker, but says nothing is better than live tournaments.

"I really love live tournaments. That's where it's at for me. Live in general feels a lot less like work," said Morris. "I love the social element of the game."

Morris has a full schedule of poker ahead of him, including playing in several more events this series to chase the Rio Casino Championship title. He also plans to play a full schedule of events this summer at the World Series of Poker. Prior to the World Series of Poker this summer, Morris has battle rap events in New York, Dublin and Oakland.

The \$21,599 score is the largest WSOP score of his career. He said that he intends to put some of it toward purchasing a new car.
