## RONALD HELD WINS 1<sup>ST</sup> CIRCUIT RING IN EVENT 11

Held thought he was playing a nightly event, and went on to win a Circuit ring

Ronald Held is the winner of Event #11: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em for \$18,066 and his biggest career cash. This is Held's first ever live tournament win and first Circuit ring. "It feels wonderful. It's great! Actually, when I was in the back room I thought I was playing in the nightly event. So I was just throwing my chips around. After I realized what I was actually playing in, I decided to play like I usually play. I try to play conservative and catch some hands."

The newly crowned champion learned to play from his son, who plays in the World Series of Poker recreationally. "He's a much better player than I am," smiles Held. "The first time I played, I didn't do too well." Held has been playing poker for 17 years now, and was relieved to finally book a win.
