ERIC RIVKIN WINS FINAL EVENT ON TUNICA SLATE

New York's Rivkin earns second career Circuit ring and \$17,161 in Event #13 triumph

Sometimes the last chance turns out to be the best chance. New York's Eric Rivkin has been present throughout the Circuit series at Horseshoe Tunica, and though he'd made it into the money earlier, he hadn't made that deep, deep run. Until tonight, that is, when he took down the final official ring tourney at Tunica, Event #13, \$400 No-Limit Hold'em Double Stack.

Rivkin, 35, originally a native of New York City, picked up his second career ring in mostly dominating fashion. He arrived at this event's final table with more than a third of his chips in play, but had to survive a late rally by eventual runner-up Jesse Lott to take this one down.

Rivkin is planning his usual trip to the summer WSOP, and this win certainly helps with expenses and the poker bankroll. Yet Rivkin won't play the entire WSOP, as he tells it. "My brother's getting married this summer -- Jason and his lovely fiancee, Stephanie, so obviously I'll be setting time aside to do that."
