## No-Limit Hold'em Championship (Televised on ESPN) SATURDAY JULY 9; SUNDAY JULY 10; MONDAY JULY 11 at 11 AM

**Starting Chips:** 50,000 (up 66% this year)

**Level Duration**: 120 minutes

**Late Registration**: 3 levels ( $\approx 7:10$  p.m.)

This event will payout 1,000 places or 15% of field,

whichever is greater

#### Day 1A, 1B, 1C: July 9-11, 2016:

11:00 a.m. Start Play 5 levels 20-min breaks after every level 90-min break after 3<sup>rd</sup> level (≈ 5:40 p.m.)

#### Day 2A and 2B: <u>July 12, 2016</u>:

Remaining players from Day 1A Remaining players from Day 1B (play separate from 1A) 11:00 a.m. Restart Play 5 levels 20-min breaks every level 90-min break after  $3^{rd}$  level ( $\approx 5:40$  p.m.)

#### Day 2C: <u>July 13, 2016</u>:

Remaining players from Day 1C 11:00 a.m. Restart Play 5 levels 20-min breaks every level 90-min break after 3<sup>rd</sup> level (≈ 5:40 p.m.)

#### Day 6: July 17, 2016

11:00 a.m. start Play 5-6 levels 20-min breaks every level 90-min break after 3<sup>rd</sup> level (≈ 5:40 p.m.)

#### Day 7: July 18, 2016

11:00 a.m. start
Play down to final 9
20-min breaks every level
90-min break after 3<sup>rd</sup> level (≈ 5:40 p.m.)

#### Day 8/9/10: October 30 to November 1

Final 9 players will resume October 30, 2016.
