Players begin with 30,000 in Tournament Chips. All levels last 60 minutes. Breaks occur after every two levels. Breaks on day one will be 15, 30, and 15 minutes. Breaks on day two and beyond will last 20 minutes with a 60 minute break after the completion of 4 levels. Play will continue on Day 1 until the completion of level 8. Day 2: play will resume at 3 PM, and play down to the final table or the completion of 10 levels, whichever comes first. Day 3: play will resume at 3 PM and continue until a winner has been determined. No more than 10 levels will be played on any single day. Play will be extended to the following day should this event require more than 10 levels of play to complete on day three. 4.2% of the total entry pool will be withheld for entry fees, and 1.8% of the total entry pool will be withheld for tournament staff.
