Rosenberg Wins Omaha High-Low Split Championship

Jeffrey Gurkinkel Holds Points Lead as Tournament Series Heads into Final Weekend

WSOP Circuit at Harrah's Atlantic City Main Event Championship on Deck – Dec. 10-12

Atlantic City, NJ (December 9, 2011) – The World Series of Poker Circuit continued tonight at the Harrah's Resort in Atlantic City. The eighth event of 12 scheduled gold ring tournaments ended with another first-time winner.

The latest tournament champion is Menachem Rosenberg, from Atlantic City. He collected \$14,148 in prize money. Rosenberg was also presented with his first WSOP Circuit gold ring, given by John Arthur – Poker Director for Harrah's Atlantic City.

The 187-player field represented a nice turnout for a non-Hold'em competition. In fact, this was the only non-Hold'em gold ring event on the schedule. The two-day \$300 (+45) Omaha High-Low Split tournament began on Thursday at 5 pm and ended late on Friday night. The total prize pool came to \$54,417. The top 21 players were paid. All players who cashed received WSOP Circuit National Championship ranking points.

With his victory, Rosenberg now jumps into the race for this WSOP Circuit's "Best All-Around Player. The player who accumulates the most overall points in Atlantic City's twelve combined gold ring tournaments receives a pre-paid entry into the \$1 million 2011-2012 WSOP Circuit National Championship, to be held in Las Vegas, next May.

At least two players from this tournament series will qualify for the WSOP Circuit National Championship, which is classified as a WSOP gold bracelet event. The other automatic qualifier will be the winner of Harrah's Atlantic City's Main Event championship. The Main Event begins Saturday, and runs over three days, ending on Monday.

In fact, there are still three more gold ring events remaining in what is being billed as a "12 rings in 12 days" poker series. The WSOP Circuit at Harrah's Atlantic City continues through December 12th. This year's schedule includes not only all the gold ring events, but multiple second-chance tournaments (at 5 pm and 7 pm most days), single table and mega satellites, plus cash games going around the clock inside the Harrah's Poker Room.
