Hundreds of thousands of dollars later, it's clear he made the right choice.

Taylor perfected his game on the WSOP Circuit and from August of 2012 on, he amassed an impressive three victories as well as donning Casino Champion honors at Horseshoe Southern Indiana and a breakthrough win in The Lodge Casino Main Event for \$138,938.

Fast forward to June 2013. This summer marks Taylor's first time to play a full schedule of events at the World Series of Poker, and, just like the Circuit, he started out hot.

Taylor won Event 14 Saturday night, adding \$454,424 to his bankroll and a gold bracelet to his three Circuit rings. Some of the Circuit's best and brightest were on hand to congratulate their fellow grinder on his victory. If past performance is any indication of the future, don't be surprised if he adds another bracelet or two between now and August.
