## **Tim Campbell Wins First Circuit Gold At Rincon**

**Valley Center, CA (December 16, 2013)** -- Heads up play began with Tim Campbell holding a 9:1 chip lead over Adrian Lopez. It didn't take long with the blinds at 12k/24k/4k ante for all the chips to go in. Lopez had pocket 2s and was racing against Campbell's AJ. The board came A K 6 3 4 and Campbell paired his Ace for the win and \$8,545, along with his first WSOP Circuit ring. Lopez earned \$5,280 for second place.

The final event of the Harrah's Rincon WSOP Circuit series began at 12 noon PST. It was a Turbo event, which meant 20-minute levels throughout. The final table came together at 6:15pm and following a dinner break, play continued until 10:20pm when it was over, after a little more than ten hours of play.

Eighty-nine players turned out and for the first time all series, *two* women made the final table. The prize pool came to \$31,800 and was paid out to the final nine players.

On his way to victory, Tim Campbell "picked good spots" and "won a couple of flips". He was short stacked when the final table formed, but held on for the win. About the stuffed koala bear in his photo, he said "It's not mine". The koala was borrowed from a friend for luck. Apparently it worked.
