Vincent Moscati Wins His Third Ring Event of the Season

Vincent Moscati becomes the first player of the 2014-2015 season to win three gold rings.

Baltimore, Md. (March 10, 2015) -- Vincent Moscati has collected his third WSOP Circuit gold ring of the 2014-2015 season by winning Event #11 – \$365 No-Limit Hold'em for \$18,595. This marks his seventh cash of the season and his largest WSOP cash ever.

This career-year for Moscati began at the Planet Hollywood stop in November. He cashed in three events, including winning the pot-limit omaha event for his first career gold ring. He followed up the strong performance in Vegas by putting together another strong Circuit stop at Harrah's Rincon in December.

At Rincon he cashed in another three events, and just like at Planet Hollywood, won one gold ring. He won the opening event of the series, which at the time was his largest WSOP score of his career. Moscati has been quiet since Rincon and had not cashed in any event until winning this one in Baltimore.

This victory has secured Moscati enough National Championship points to earn one of the 56 at-large bids. This will be the first time Moscati will be heading to the National Championship and he is thrilled to be going.”

“I would love to win a bracelet to go along with these rings,” said Moscati about the National Championship.

The professional poker player has earned \$65,150 on the Circuit this year alone, with four five-figure cashes. He said that he doesn't play a whole lot of tournaments, but plays them if they happen to be where he is. A fourth gold ring is not out of the question for Moscati, with still five more Circuit stops left on this season's schedule.

Event #11 was the eleventh of 12 gold ring events on the WSOP Circuit schedule at the Horseshoe Baltimore. The \$365 No-Limit Hold'em tournament attracted 253 players generating a \$75,900 prize pool. The top 27 players were paid.

The tournament began Sunday at 5 p.m. and lasted 15 levels. Day 2 began Monday at 3 p.m. with 33 players remaining. The tournament concluded Monday at about 11:45 p.m.

The player who accumulates the most overall points during the Horseshoe Baltimore's twelve combined gold ring tournaments earns the title Casino Champion and receives automatic entry into the WSOP National Championship set to take place at the end of the year.

All players who cash in ring events receive points that apply toward the Casino Championship race and the season-long race to claim one of 56 at-large National Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season. More information on the points system is available on WSOP.com.
