Timothy Little Wins the Turbo Event

Timothy Little takes the gold in the final event in Baltimore.

Baltimore, **Md.** (**March 9, 2015**) -- The final event at the 2014-2015 Horseshoe Baltimore WSOP Circuit series was a one-day turbo event. This was the only turbo event of the entire series. Timothy Little was the man to come out on top of this fast and furious tournament. This marks Little's first WSOP Circuit gold ring and 15th WSOP related cash.

This victory caps off a strong series for Little. This marks his third cash of the series and puts his earnings over the \$18,000 mark for the series. This victory comes shortly after a disappointing, yet strong finish in the Main Event.

Little went deep into Day 2 of the Main Event before busting in 23rd place for \$7,306. It was disappointing finish for Little, getting so close to the final table and just missing out, but still an impressive run to be able get that deep in a 670 player field.

Little made the best of the tough luck in the Main Event and hopped into the turbo event the next day, which was the last day of the series. The event, as advertised, went quickly. It lasted just over ten hours long. Little defeated a tough final table that included gold ring win winners, Justin Liberto and Andy Spears. Liberto has gone on to win this stop's Casino Championship title after recording his third final table of the series in this event.

Little said that his game was well suited for this type of event. He enjoys playing one-day daily and weekly tournaments that have similar structures to this turbo tournament.

Event #12 was the final of 12 gold ring events on the WSOP Circuit schedule at the Horseshoe Baltimore. The \$365 No-Limit Hold'em Turbo tournament attracted 141 players generating a \$42,300 prize pool. The top 15 players were paid.

The one day tournament began Monday at noon and concluded at about 10:30 p.m.

Notes on the event:

• This was Justin Liberto's (6thh place) third final table of the series. In all four of Liberto's Circuit cashes on the year, he has reached the final table.

The player who accumulates the most overall points during the Horseshoe Baltimore's twelve combined gold ring tournaments earns the title Casino Champion and receives automatic entry into the WSOP National Championship set to take place at the end of the year.

All players who cash in ring events receive points that apply toward the Casino Championship race and the season-long race to claim one of 56 at-large National Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season. More information on the points system is available on WSOP.com.
