Christopher Carey Wins Again

Christopher Carey wins his second gold ring of the series to lock up the Casino Championship.

Cherokee, N.C. (April 24, 2016) -- Maurice Hawkins has stolen the show on the Circuit this month with his three gold rings and two Main Event victories. The only man seemingly able to slow down Hawkins has been Christopher Carey. Carey defeated Hawkins heads-up in Event #4 - \$365 No-Limit Hold'em. Hawkins then went on to win series' Main Event and while he was doing that Carey was busy winning Event #12 to lock up the Casino Championship.

Carey has won Event #12 - \$365 No-Limit Hold'em for his second ring of the series. Carey cashed five times and won two gold rings over the course of the 12-event series to earn 117.5 points Casino Championship points. He blew the competition out of the water and had more than twice as many points as all other competitors except for one.

Carey said that he is excited to be part of the 2016 Global Casino Championship and is happy that it is in his home state of North Carolina. Until then, Carey will be busy in Las Vegas this summer. He plans to play a full schedule of WSOP events with most being no-limit hold'em and pot-limit omaha events.

Carey earned \$19,658 for his Event #12 victory. This marked his 10th Circuit cash and pushed his career Circuit earnings over \$75k.

Event #12 was the final of 12 gold ring events on the WSOP Circuit schedule at the Harrah's Cherokee series. The \$365 No-Limit Hold'em tournament attracted 273 players generating a \$81,900 prizepool. The top 30 players were paid.

Day 1 began Sunday at 4 p.m. and lasted 15 levels. Day 2 began Monday at 1 p.m. with 27 players remaining. The tournament concluded at about 7:50 p.m. Monday midway through Level 24.

All players who cash in ring events receive points that apply toward the Casino Championship race and the season-long race to claim one of 50 at-large Global Casino Championship bids awarded to the top point earners throughout the season.
