Adrian Mateos Wins \$10,000 Heads-Up Championship

The 2013 WSOP Europe Main Event Champion becomes the youngest player to win three bracelets.

The 22-year-old poker pro defeated 129 players and John Smith in the finals to win \$324,470.

Smith finishes second in this event for the second year in a row after finishing second in 2016 to Alan Percal.
