Warren Bishop Wins the PLO Event

Bishop wins a ring in his first ever played WSOP event.

The second tournament on the 2018 Horseshoe Tunica Circuit schedule was Pot-Limit Omaha. The tournament drew 86 players and quickly played down to the money bubble with 10 players remaining. The bubble lasted over two hours before unlucky Warren Sheaves busted empty handed. After the long money bubble, the tournament quickly whittled its way down to the final few players before the scheduled bagging. Tournament staff allowed play to continue instead of bagging and 15 minutes later Warren Bishop had claimed his first WSOP Circuit gold ring and the top prize of \$8,256.

Bishop outlasted an 86-player field and survived a two and a half hour bubble on his way to victory. He attributed patience to his success. He stayed patient during the money bubble and held onto his chip lead for most of it.

"I donked off a bunch of chips one time. I am proud to say it was only once," said Bishop.

He was happy with his play and described his win as "exhilarating." When asked, Bishop said that he prefers Pot-Limit Omaha over No-Limit Hold'em.

Bishop said that he may return tomorrow for one more event, but that will be it for his series. He returns to Ole Miss Monday for his final semester of college.
