John Jacob Takes Home the Gold in Event #5

John Jacob wins gold in his first ever played WSOP Circuit event.

For the second time this series, a player has won a Circuit ring playing in their first WSOP Circuit event ever. Last Thursday, Warren Bishop accomplished the feat in Event #2: \$365 No-Limit Hold'em and today John Jacob matched Bishop's accomplishment by taking down Event #5: \$365 No-Limit Hold'em in his first WSOP Circuit event played ever.

"This was my first WSOP ring event. I was actually not planning on coming out, but my friend convinced me to come out to Tunica," said Jacob. "This is one of the biggest tournaments in terms of money and competition that I have ever played."

Jacob is a student from Texas and considers poker a hobby. He said he doesn't play often now because his studies take the majority of his time, but hopes he has more time for poker in the future.

Jacob will return to school with an extra \$16,727 in his pocket, a WSOP Circuit gold ring and a great story for his friends.
