Moin Kazi Wins in First Ever WSOP Event

Moin Kazi takes down the one-day tourney for \$18,888 and a WSOP Circuit ring.

For the third time this series, a player has a WSOP Circuit gold ring in their first WSOP event ever played. This was the first time Moin Kazi had ever played in a WSOP event and he took it down, defeating a 257-player field for \$18,888 and a WSOP Circuit gold ring.

"Unbelievable," said Kazi. "I was not expecting to that I would win. This is the first time I have ever played any of these events.

Kazi joined Warren Bishop and John Jacob as players this series to win in their first played WSOP event ever. Kazi satellited into this tournament a few hours beforehand for just \$65.

Kazi is a physician from Atlanta, Georgia. He was born in Karachi, Pakistan and moved to the Unites States in 1992.
