KEVIN EYSTER WINS 3RD CAREER RING IN SIX-MAX AT TULSA

Eyster, a six-max specialist, has already won a ring in this format.

22 March 2018 (Tulsa, Okla.) – Kevin Eyster is adding another piece of hardware to his trophy case – he just won the \$365 No-Limit Hold'em 6-Handed event at the Hard Rock Tulsa WSOP Circuit, earning his third career Circuit ring (to go with his WSOP bracelet) and \$22,538.

Eyster said afterwards it was a tough tournament, and a difficult one for him to win. "It feels good. I had some highs and lows in this tourney for sure. I got super lucky in some spots and super unlucky in some spots. It was just an unbelievable roller coaster, so I'm glad it went my way in the end, but I could've ended up in any [of the last seven places]. It definitely wasn't one where I came in feeling comfortable at all. I'm just glad I ended up with the 'W'.

"[The final table] was rough. I don't even want to think back on all the hands. It was just a lot of highs and lows. I lost to a two-outer to end the day yesterday, then two three-outers today. Then I finally got a momentum change when I won ace-seven vs. ace-six blind-on-blind. Then snap-lost a three outer to Orlando [Romero] after. The rollercoaster of emotions was tough. "

Eyster is a six-max specialist, and many of his signature victories over the years have come in this format. After two today, two of his three Circuit rings have come in six-handed tournaments – the first was also in Oklahoma, at Choctaw Durant over five years ago. And his WSOP bracelet came in the \$5,000 six-handed event in 2014.
