Chris Fuchs, a Chicago native, has just come away with his first career gold ring. This is his first big win after ten years of playing poker recreationally. The 41 year old outlasted a massive field of 2,563 to take home \$124,385. Fuchs is in IT Sales which he will be calling in sick tomorrow to.

Fuchs came into the final table as the chip leader, James Gregg who he defeated heads up was among the shorter stacks after bagging the chip lead on Day 1C. Fuchs said he “stuck it out most of the day, I got a lot of good hands, I got the cards and ran well”

This is Fuchs fifth year playing the Hammond Circuit series and he was thrilled to score his first WSOP ring. He says he wasn't planning on it but is now going to return next weekend for his shot at the Main Event.
