Dylan Wilkerson Win His Third Ring

Dylan Wilkerson cashes three out of the final four events at the PH series and wins third ring.

Dylan Wilkerson has claimed the final Circuit ring at the Planet Hollywood Circuit series. Wilkerson defeated a 176-player field in Event #14: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em (One-Day) to score a \$15,680 and earn his third career Circuit ring.

Wilkerson's day began with him playing in series' \$2,200 high roller event. Wilkerson made the money in the tournament, but was the first one out after the money was reached. He finished in 12th place out of 98 entries for a \$4,094 payday. It would turn out that wouldn't end up being Wilkerson's biggest score of the day.

"I got 12th in the high roller and I jumped in this last minute. It turned out to be a good decision," said Wilkerson.

A good decision it was indeed because nine hours after being eliminated from the high roller, Wilkerson went on to win this event.

"It always feels good to win," said Wilkerson. "No matter how many times you have done it before, it always feels good."

Wilkerson has won two <u>World Series of Poker</u> Circuit events prior to this victory. Both those prior wins came in WSOP Circuit Main Events. His first was in 2017 at the Los Angeles Bicycle stop for \$216,790 and his most recent came April 2018 at the Harrah's Cherokee stop for \$294,152.

Wilkerson is a Las Vegas-based tournament poker pro. Wilkerson said he plans on heading out to LA next week for the Bicycle Casino WSOP Circuit Main Event, which is scheduled to begin Sunday, December 9.
