LESLIE SCEARCY WINS \$250 NO-LIMIT HOLD'EM SINGLE-DAY

Poker Dealer from Central California enacts revenge on Peter Hengsakul to score her first ring and \$16,090.

Before Wednesday, Leslie Scearcy's biggest tournament score was for \$8,780. It was a fifth-place finish at another major tournament series in Los Angeles in 2015. She was eliminated by Peter Hengsakul. Hengsakul went on to win that tournament and continued on after that to have a successful poker career.

The two didn't meet again until late on Wednesday night when they were seated next to each other at the final table of the \$250 no-limit hold'em single-day event to close out the World Series of Poker Circuit stop at the Bicycle Hotel and Casino.

The final table gradually shrank from nine-handed all the way down to heads-up play, where Hengsakul and Scearcy were heads-up and battling for the final ring of the series.

This time, it was Scearcy who reigned supreme. After turning the nut straight against Hengsakul's top pair, she got her revenge on the Southern California grinder. Hengsakul was eliminated in second for \$9,955, while the poker dealer from Central California scored her first victory and \$16,090.

This was Scearcy's first cash in a WSOP-branded event and it more than doubled her career earnings.
