OMAR MEHMOOD WINS H.O.R.S.E. EVENT FOR FIRST RING

Foster City, CA's Mehmood triumphs over Event #4's 62-player field to earn \$7,162

Omar Mehmood has a two-part life: Work some, play some, and don't worry too much when the work becomes play or vice versa. Mehmood, a Circuit semi-regular in recent years, juggles his time at the tables with his own freelance consulting work as a data architect as time allows.

Today, it was all about the poker, as Mehmood took down what he claimed was his first outright win in a formal poker event of any kind, claiming his first gold Circuit ring and the \$7,162 first-place money in Event #4 at Circuit Thunder Valley, \$400 H.O.R.S.E.

Mehmood, who plays plenty of hold'em and Omaha but claims to be less than experienced at this format's other three variants, still found a way to outduel prior WSOP bracelet winner Andrew Barber for the ring. Mehmood has played on bigger stages, though; last summer, he took third place in the WSOP's \$565 PLO event that drew over 2,400 entries. Despite his \$81,852 payday there, though, no jewelry was involved, a situation Mehmood fixed today.
