MARK BARRIENTOS CLAIMS SINGLE-DAY NLHE RING

Wichita, Kansas's Barrientos wins first ring and \$11,348 in Event #11 victory

48-year-old Mark Barrientos has taken home the first gold Circuit ring of his career and an \$11,348 payday for winning Event #11 at Circuit Hard Rock Tulsa, \$250 No-Limit Hold'em (1 Day).

Barrientos rode a classic final-table heater to what turned out to be a fast-paced rout, as he busted several of his foes on the way to the win. "I just kept busting them out after they thought [their hands] were good," he said.

Barrientos was both elated and relieved to have claimed that first Circuit ring, which is the largest poker victory of his career. "I've been trying for, like, three years to win one," he said. "It's hard. I'm just crazy right now. I've never won a ring." Barrientos' ring-winning performance comes in just his third recorded Circuit cash.
