ZACHARY MULLENNIX FINISHES COMEBACK IN EVENT #4

Ft. Lauderdale pro goes from last to first on Day 2 to earn \$19,758 and first career Circuit ring

Pittsburgh (PA) native Zachary Mullennix barely made it to Day 2 of Event #4 at Circuit Coconut Creek, \$600 No-Limit Hold'em. Once there, however, he made the day a worst-to-first story, ending up with the ring and a \$19,758 winner's payday in surprising style.

It almost didn't happen at all, as Mullennix came close to busting outside the money as Day 1 action closed. He returned in 15th out of 15 spots to a chip stack just eight big blinds deep and was in immediate danger of finishing with a min-cash payday early on Day 2. Instead, Mullennix doubled up on the day's second hand, caught some good fortune later on, then made a crucial read to pick off an all-in bluff in the event's final hand to secure the win.

The 27-year-old poker pro has enjoyed considerable success since relocating to Florida four years ago to play poker full time, and he's had larger tourney scores, though this is his biggest event victory to date. Mullennix splits his time between tourney and cash-game play.
