RAFFAELLO LOCATELLI WINS EVENT NLHE 6-MAX RING

Prior International Circuit ring winner earns \$25,667 in Event #7 win

Raffaello Locatelli found himself heads-up against one of the giants of the WSOP Circuit tour on Wednesday in Event #7, \$600 No-Limit Hold'em Six-Handed. Locatelli was matched against nine-time ring winner Martin Ryan of Trinidad and Tobago, who had won nine rings in just the past two years. The two started with almost equal stacks, and if Locatelli was the underdog, he didn't show it, quickly eliminating Ryan to earn his own second career ring.

Locatelli, 52, is a native of Rome, Italy who now lives in New York City, where he works in finance on behalf of a venture-capital fund. His work takes him around the globe, and when he travels, he tries to schedule himself into large poker events when he can. Two years ago he won an International Circuit ring in Cannes, France, winning a high-roller event at asino Barriere, and today he repeated the feat in taking down Circuit Coconut Creek's short-handed event.
