JUSTIN HARVELL WINS MONSTER STACK AT COCO

Nashville' Harvell breaks through after going ringless in 10 previous Circuit final tables

Nashville, Tennessee's Justin Harvell has emerged as the winner of the Monster Stack tournament (Event #8, \$400 No-Limit Hold'em) at Circuit Coconut Creek. Harvell earned his first career Circuit ring and \$37,914 after dominating most of the Monster Stack's final-table action, breaking his own personal ringless streak in Circuit action. Harvell had cashed in 21 previous Circuit events, making 10 previous final tables without a win, before breaking through here.

One of Harvell's three previous Circuit runner-up showings came right here at Coconut Creek in the same event one year ago, making this win that much sweeter. Nice as it is, the big payday isn't the largest cash of Harvell's career; the 28-year-old also ran deep in last year's WSOP Main Event, finishing 97th for \$66,330.

"I'm just so happy," Harvell said. "That's the main thing. I'm just really happy I finally won and now I can build up from here.... I'm so very thankful. It should be the main focus, really, how thankful and grateful I am."
