AARON WALLACE GRABS PLO RING AT COCONUT CREEK

2015 WSOP Pot-limit Omaha bracelet winner earns \$10,099 and first Circuit ring

Aaron Wallace, a native of Carmel, Indiana who has recently moved to northern California, has earned the first WSOP Circuit ring of his career for triumphing in Event #9 at Coconut Creek, \$400 Pot-Limit Hold'em. Wallace collected \$10,099 for the win.

Wallace, 35, is "only" a semipro player, though he's very much a PLO specialist and expert, having already won a WSOP bracelet in this format in 2015. Even then – and though he plays PLO tournaments whenever he can -- this one wasn't originally on his schedule.

Instead, he'd been in southern Florida looking to buy a truck for use around his family's new home near northern California's Tahoe National Forest. "That deal fell through, and I didn't even know this event was going on. I called a friend and he was like, 'Hey, there's a PLO event going on tomorrow. You should play.' So, here we are! I was going to buy a truck, but I'm going back with a ring instead."
