CURTIS DAYE WINS COCONUT CREEK HIGH ROLLER

Jamaica-born Daye makes first Circuit cash a ring-winning effort

Curtis Daye, a native of Jamaica who now lives in the greater Miami area, has claimed the largest payday of his poker career, earning \$73,500 for triumphing in Event #10 at Circuit Coconut Creek, \$3,250 No-Limit Hold'em High Roller. The win also gave Daye his first gold Circuit ring and marked his first major win in any poker series.

The 45-year-old Daye describes himself as a businessman and "recreational" poker player, though he's recorded numerous other tourney cashes in both southern Florida and Las Vegas. However, he'd had nothing in any WSOP-branded event, before today's win.

"I started yesterday really pretty steady, I must say," he told the WSOP. "And I came this morning, came up today, with good intentions. And it was a little bit challenging - the guys played well, but in the end I had my focus and the goal in mind. I just called my girlfriend and I was like, I need a ring. I was determined and I did it!" he said, with a laugh.
