DAVID MOSES TRIUMPHS IN EVENT #12, NLHE TURBO

North Carolina's Moses mounts heads-up comeback to win \$10,591, first Circuit ring

Asheville, North Carolina's David Moses has earned his first career Circuit ring, along with a \$10,591 winner's payday, after coming from well behind at the final table of Event #12, \$400 No-Limit Hold'em Turbo (1 Day). The cash was the second-largest of Moses' WSOP Circuit career, trailing only a big payday he earned for final-tabling a big-field event at Cherokee, NC.

The 36-year-old Moses didn't have it easy, and he ended up outlasting a couple of goliaths of the Circuit tour on his way to the win. First, five-time ringwinner John Holley held a big lead, and when Holley faltered, nine-time ringwinner Martin Ryan dominated the counts. Moses trailed Ryan by more than 3:1 in chips when heads-up play began, but got the better side of a couple of big-hand collisions to come out on top.

Moses though, wasn't daunted, particular during heads-up play. He's a long-time online player with a fondness for HUNL (heads-up no-limit hold'em), and he thought it factored into his win. "As good as he is, I've probably played more heads-up matches. I knew I probably had an edge there," regarding his final duel against the skilled Ryan.
