### **RON ROBINSON WINS 1<sup>st</sup> WSOP CIRCUIT RING**

*Robinson amounts a colossal comeback to win Event #6 and \$14,190*

Ron Robinson, an insurance data analyst and part-time poker player from Dallas, Texas, just overcame a 3-1 heads-up chip deficit to win his first World Series of Poker Circuit ring Monday night. Robinson maneuvered his way through the one-day Event #7 field that hosted 166 entrants, earning himself \$14,190 in the process.

During three-handed play, Robinson exclaimed, "I'm just looking for a pay-jump" while he was anxiously watching his opponents in an all-in pot. Unfortunately for Ron, he didn't ladder in that hand however a few moments later, the 58-year-old Richardson, Texas resident Eric Ritter was eliminated, giving him the pay jump he hoped for. Ritter lost his remaining chips to two-time WSOP ring earner Anthony "Burt" Bogard, who had heaps of chips heading into the grueling heads-up duel.

"I'm really surprised, the main reason is when I got to the pay jump when the gentleman got out and I was heads-up that I was at such disadvantage. I was just kind of grinding-it-out. I believe as the night progressed he got tired. I think it was the moment that when I colored-up and got those blue 25,000 chips that he started to realize that I was coming back. Even though he had a 3-1 chip lead on me, I think he got a little disappointed about that. I realized when the chips were going down and when I started to go all-in at the end, it really started to hit home with him that, "oh, wow I could lose this thing. If I just got the pay jump, I would've been happy."

After a unsuccessful weekend at Choctaw, Robinson headed back home and had no plans of coming back. It wasn't until Monday morning that he last minute decided to take another

shot at some WSOP hardware. He ended up making the right decision, a decision that earned him his first WSOP cash and his first career ring.
