### **DAVID LARSON DOMINANT IN 3<sup>RD</sup> WSOP CIRCUIT VICTORY**

*On his way to the Casino Championship, Larson stops at Choctaw and wins \$400 Event #7*

David Larson is now part of an exclusive club, one that only a few others can say they're apart of. The 48-year-old is now the 132<sup>nd</sup> player to earn three WSOP rings. Larson etched his name in the record books Tuesday night when he took down the \$400 Event #7: No-Limit Hold'em for \$11,057. Larson was dominant on his way to victory, owning the Day 1 chip lead as well as coming into the Final Table with a colossal 144 big blinds.

The Las Vegas, Nevada resident was traveling to the Global Casino Championship when he decided to stop at Choctaw and take a shot at more WSOP hardware. He qualified for the Championship seat by earning the most points at the 2018/2019 Horseshoe Hammond Circuit series last October where he twice finished runner-up. The former software engineer hopes to take his newfound confidence into the Casino Championship that will be taking place next month.

In the last hand of the entertaining heads-up match, Larson managed to crack the kings of Houston, Texas resident Larry Green in a pot that was all-in on a flopped board of Jh-2s-3s. With the suited ace on the turn, Larson's Js-6s won him not only all the chips in the middle but also his 3<sup>rd</sup> career ring.
