ZACHARY MULLENNIX CLAIMS SECOND CIRCUIT RING IN EVENT #3

He collects \$26,412 for his win

After two days of play, Event #3: \$1,125 No-Limit Hold'em is in the books and it is Zachary Mullennix who was the last man standing out of a field of 89 players. Mullennix takes home his second Circuit ring and \$26,412 for his first-place finish.

"It's really cool. I wasn't even sure if I was going to play this event and I decided it to fire it. I'm really lucky to get the win," Mullennix said after his victory.

With five ring winners at the final table, the road to the finish line wasn't an easy one. Mullennix started the final table with an average stack but he quickly moved forward after winning multiple pots and had more than half of the chips of play when four players were left.

"It was really a couple of big hands, particularly against Ryan (Van Sanford) where I just had good hands. He was in a position where he was going to be bluffing a lot, and I was able to put chips in the pot and win the hand."

After the elimination of Wilfor Marentes in fourth place, the three-handed portion of play only lasted a couple of hands as Mullennix won a three-way all in preflop with queens against Sam Panzica's deuces and Ryan Van Sanford's eights to eliminate his last two opponents and win the tournament.

With already a victory under his belt this series, Mullennix intends on chasing the casino champion title.

“Now that I won first place, I guess I got to try to go for the points.”
