Wanlop Phonphornwithoon was crowned the champion of Event #5: \$400 Double Stack Turbo on Monday evening at the World Series of Poker Circuit series at the Seminole Casino Coconut Creek. He took home \$16,720 and his first trophy ring after defeating 209 players.

Phonphornwithoon felt some relief after winning his first Circuit event.

"I feel really good. I tried many times and I finally got it."

The final table was reached at Level 25 and Phonphornwithoon was third in chips when it started. Between his good fortune and good performance, he quickly started chipping up and took over the lead.

"I ran really hot. I had a lot pocket pairs, flopped sets, turned a nut flush...Everything was going my way. It was unbelievable!"

The final table was fast-paced and action-packed. Within an hour, Phonphornwithoon found himself heads up against ring winner Elliott Merlin and only took another level to close it out and claim the title.

Phonphornwithoon owns a restaurant and only plays poker recreationally, but he plans on

firing more events this series.
