Justin Geary Takes Home First WSOP Circuit Gold Ring at Horseshoe Casino, Southern Indiana

Justin Geary tops 44 player field in \$400

Justin Geary has won his first World Series of Poker Circuit gold ring in Event #7: \$400 Pot-Limit Hold'em defeating a field of 44 players for \$14,523 at Horseshoe Casino, Southern Indiana.

This was a 2-Day event, with the players landing on the final table on Day 1. Geary found himself third in chips when they reached the final table with 151,000 and managed to hold onto those chips finishing the day still in third with 164,000.

Geary landed heads up with Ross Schitter and they were about even-stacked. After about a 45-minute battle of back and forth, Geary eliminated Schitter in second place, earning himself \$14,523, his first WSOP Circuit gold ring and 50 points towards the 2020 Global Casino Championship.

He is normally a cash game player but enjoys tournaments as well, "I normally play omaha cash games, but I was about 70% sure I was going to win when Day 2 began," he said.

Geary says he is not too sure if he will be playing the Main Event at Horseshoe just yet, but he will definitely be in cash games throughout the weekend.
