Tim Garles Takes Home First WSOP Circuit Gold Ring at Horseshoe Casino, Southern Indiana

Tim Garles tops 123 player field in \$400 No-Limit Hold'em

Tim Garles took down Event #9: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em, defeating a field of 123 entries for \$11,057 and earning his first World Series of Poker Circuit gold ring, along with 50 points towards the 2020 Global Casino Championship at Horseshoe Casino, Southern Indiana.

Garles came into Day 2 as the chipleader and stayed confident throughout, gaining chips along the way. His game has been constantly improving he explains, "I have been working really hard, my coach is Jeff Fielder. I definitely have to thank him."

When play was down to three-handed Garles defended his pocket deuces and flopped a set against Jesse Carter's made flush and the river paired to give him a full house eliminating Carter in third place.

Garles went into heads up with a 5-1 chiplead and took very little time to get all the chips in the middle, sending Mitchell Foss to the payout desk in second place.

Garles is a well-known Circuit grinder, following stops all over and is no stranger to the final table. He has come close to a ring on several occasions, but he felt like his first ring got ripped away from him in 2018 WSOP Circuit at the Bicycle Casino when he made it to heads up with a dominating chiplead and ended up coming in second place.

Garles is hoping to take home a second ring during this series, "I am just going to keep playing tournaments," He said.
