Jonathan Honeycutt just claimed his first Circuit ring after taking down the first event of the IP Biloxi Circuit series, Event #1: \$400 No-Limit Hold'em Double Stack (1 Day). He topped a field of 148 players and collected \$12,946 for his victory.

The stakes were high at the final table as multiple notables were still in contention and Honeycutt stayed humble when talking about his victory.

"I feel pretty good, it was a tough final table. When we were down to five, the players left were all very good players. It's great to win. We were all short-stacked here at the final table so it could have been anybody's ring. I ran really great, there were a lot of spots that I was all in behind and I managed to get there."

The 36-year old software engineer doesn't plan on stopping here.

"I will probably play the PLO next."
